1. Be confident.

2. Be parental
/ encouraging.

3. Be gentle.

4. Be forgettable.

Love	Patience	Faithfulness
Joy	Kindness	Gentleness
Peace	Goodness	Sel-control

3 Basic steps in receiving:

1. Seeker prays/seeks vulnerably
2. Jesus pours out Holy Spirit
3. Spirit begins to prompt,
seeker begins to speak
